WHY NOT TRY? / IT WOULD BE A GOOD IDEA TO ...

We have conducted a brainstorming session titled: "How to communicate with local clubs/associations in Ettelbruck region and joint action?"

NECESSARY CONDITIONS: MATERIAL / PLACE / TIME

We conducted workshops with our students. We have tried to resolved: how to improve relationship between local clubs/associations in Ettelbruck region and the Club Senior?

Participation in EU projects , encourage people from different organisations to apply together/ 2 times a year	Motivating members to attend in common events: visit to the theatre, exhibition, Nordic walking/ 2 times a month/ 2 h
Finding the common problem of the local level for all organisations and trying to solve it together (and fighting together!) / 2 times a year (if necessary)	Disseminating information about Senior Club, providing trainings for managing board, printing brochures for local people/ two times a month / 1 h
Organising events with the profitable aspect (in emotional contex) e.g. organizing competition named "Volunteer of the year" /one time a year	Organising common activities to improve memory and concentration of attention, with logical plays/ two times a month /1 h
Engage, involve in the topic a professional mediator / one time a month / 2h	Integration school children to work together with seniors from different organisations/ one time a month / 2 h

POSSIBLE OBSTACLES

- The staff members of local associations will not accept proposed initiatives.
- They afraid that Senior Club will be competing with their organisation.
- Relationship between local clubs and the Club will be still distanced.
