MAR MENOR MURCIA (SPAIN)



There is a place which has a great charm for me: the **Mar Menor** [Minor Sea]. It is located in the Murcia province, near the town of San Pedro del Pinatar, where I was born and spent part of my youth.

This sea is practically closed, like a lake, except for a connection with the Mediterranean Sea, in La Manga. Now it has a canal so that boats can go from one sea to the other and the old connection, the weirs, a shallow area where traditional craft fishing was practised; they made fences for the fish to go in and that fish was kept alive until the fishermen collected it.

The salinity of water in this sea is much higher than usual because of its great evaporation. This is so because the temperature is very high in summer due to its characteristics: being practically a lake and not very deep, less than 7 meters.

It is an ideal place for practising water sports and, of course, for swimming. Its high salinity makes it easier to float and, besides, it is good for bone-related problems.

For me, San Juan Beach in Alicante is a very special place that brings me many memories because it has been present in my life since my childhood.

For many years, it was the place where I used to spend the summer together with my family and where we established our place of residence.

LO PAGAN MURCIA (SPAIN)

One of my charming spots, the chosen one, lies on the border between the provinces of Alicante and Murcia, the first town in the Murcia region travelling along the coast southwards; we are speaking about San Pedro del Pinatar; taking that road, on the left, we can see *La Casa del Reloj* [The Clock House] (an eclectic building, after many debates, a definition which is not accepted by all experts in art) nowadays, it has become a (charming, tasteful) restaurant after its rehabilitation but it used to be the summer house of a marquis and marquess who lived in Murcia and had the privilege of putting up a very ill Mr Emilio Castelar for his possible recovery.

This place is linked to my life because that is where I was born and it keeps my maternal roots. I haven't lived there on a continuous basis, I left when I was four months old because my father was a civil guard, but I went there during my childhood, adolescence and youth for the summer holidays and on some other occasions. That was where my grandmother's house stood, a real privilege 50m away from the Mar Menor beach (my childhood friends envied me). For me, it is a beautiful place with the two seas (*Mediterráneo* and *Menor*); it is the end or the beginning of La Manga (depending on what direction you are taking); it has a Natural Park which receives birds, especially flamingos, every year; saltworks where people plaster themselves with the magical mud that relieves all the pains and a lake called Mar Menor, which is unique in my opinion. There are still unspoilt beaches, like La Llana on the Mediterranan, where having a swim or going for a walk is a good experience.











This place is very significant for me because that is where I spent my first summer holidays. My parents bought a holiday flat there in a residential area called 'Las Torres [The Towers].'.

Apart from making lots of friends and having my uncles, aunts and cousins there too, we enjoyed ourselves a lot at the spa of our the residential area. It is one of the biggest. It is still standing and in very good condition.





- We can highlight the choice of the sea as the favourite spot by most workshop participants. Living in Alicante, a city by the sea, has had an enormous influence, to such an extent that it has become a reference place for most people.
