



Personal achievement

- 1. A vast majority of the participants present at the Italian meeting has a very positive opinion about the planning, the organisation, the development of activities within the Project and about the evolution of learning due to their involvement in it. In fact, the options "I don't agree" or "I don't agree at all" were never chosen by our participants.
- 2. The most consensual subjects for the respondents, being mostly answered with the options "I agree" or "I totally agree" were items 2.3 ("Creativity was expected and systematically valued"), 3.2 ("You are satisfied with your understanding of the activities and goals of the project"), 3.6 ("Men and women were provided with equal tasks"), 3.7 ("The planned activities were totally executed"), 5.2 ("Your plan was realistic and viable") while item 6.4 ("The multi-cultural perspectives present in the activities of the project enriched you personally") is the most positive one with all 25 answers saying they feel totally enriched multiculturally speaking.

- 3. However, though a really small minority in the group of participants, some elements don't have any opinion or don't give any answer about certain aspects of the partnership process:
- 5 participants in 25 don't seem to have a clear idea whether the proposed activities and materials were presented in an interesting, creative manner (item 2.4), which is a negative result considering the clarity of the statement and the effort put by every national delegation.
- 4. From the answers analysed, we can one again conclude that item 5 of the questionnaire (Learning strategies) is satisfactory in a high degree for the whole group, as does this time also item 6 (Personal achievement): all the answers are positive and most of the participants say they totally agree with the statements. The homogeneity on this last item is doubly important once the participants show to feel rewarded personally through their participation in the project.

Conclusions
