1) SOCIAL SKILLS WORKSHOPS AND TRAINING GROUPS

For persons with specific difficulties related to their professional occupation, having to cope with conflicts, stress and important demands.

Through: > situation analysis

simulation and role-play

> exchange of ideas and tricks of the trade









2) STUDY CIRCLES & BUDGET MANAGEMENT

For persons with social insertion difficulties and a low selfesteem profile.

Through:

- > experimentation of new attitudes
- > discussion of alternative solutions
- > reactivation of dormant talents









3) SENIOR CITIZENS REMINISCENCE GROUPS

For aged citizens in institutions requiring special attention: aphasia, Alzheimer syndrome, deafness,...

To stimulate memory, reconnect relationships, encourage selfexpression and social interaction.

By:

- ➤ listening and telling stories on a wide variety of subjects (arts, places, occupations, etc.)
- > talking about personal interests and tastes discovering new conversation subjects









4) ENGLISH LANGUAGE WORKSHOPS FOR SENIORS

For persons who whish to improve their English language skills

- By: > conversation tables on a variety of topics
 - ➤ talking about personal interests and tastes using role plays and communication games
