Zebra's actions are focused on groups with specific needs or with particular profiles such as

- * Deprived persons (on self-esteem, budget management, in search of adequate housing).
- * Senior citizens in residences (reminiscence groups for cognitive stimulation)
- * Adults in specialized adapted work centres (disabled persons).



Zebra is currently setting up targeted language courses for asylum seekers and native illiterate persons employed in adapted work enterprises.



Zebra received the Grundtvig prize for Creativity and Innovation from its National Agency in 2009.

It was chosen by its National Agency to present "Lifestyles Revisited" at a conference in Brussels as a model partnership and project in September 2013.
